

Your new awning is a quality product from Lewens. We use only high-grade fabrics and components that have been tested for their durability in the manufacture of our awnings.

Acrylic and polyester fabrics from Lewens are manufactured and certified according to the latest standard. They are distinguished by their superior quality and durability. Awning fabrics from Lewens are:

- light-resistant and colourfast
- weatherproof and rot-resistant
- water-repellent and fast-drying
- resistant to environmental impact thanks to **Teflon** and **Cleangard treatment**



- heat- and cold-resistant
- tear-resistant
- permeable to air
- easy to clean

Lewens awning fabrics are spun-dyed and extremely colourfast. In the **spinning jet dyeing process**, the dye pigments are incorporated directly into the base material when spinning the fibres. This ensures high UV resistance and colour stability. The seams are also made up with UV-resistant, tear-proof **GORE TENARA sewing thread**.

Acrylic fabrics exhibit extreme durability and a textile character with a pleasant feel.

Polyester fabrics are especially elastic and have a pleasantly soft finish. They have good recovery properties, giving rise to a smooth fabric.

Guaranteed quality:

Lewens awning fabrics are tested and certified according to the **Oeko-Tex Standard 100**. They do not contain any harmful materials or chemicals.



Regular cleaning and care can extend the life of your awning considerably.

Vibrant colours and a clean surface depend not only on the quality of the awning fabric, but on various environmental influences, weathering, the design and location of the awning and naturally also on regular cleaning and care:

In the event of wind and rain, you must retract your awning, likewise at night.

If the awning was wet when retracted, please extend it immediately after the rain has stopped so that it can dry.

In the case of snow, please retract the awning immediately, after removing any snow lying on the fabric. A frozen awning must thaw before being retracted!

Cleaning a soiled awning:

Dissolve loose dirt and dust using a garden hose and clean water and then hose off. Do not use a pressure washer!

Light stains and soiling can be treated with a 5-10% solution of mild detergent or neutral soap and tepid water (max. 40 °). Foam up the cleaning solution using a sponge and then apply the foam to the stains and let it take effect. Rinse with plenty of clean water to remove the detergent without leaving any residues.

Warning:

No vigorous rubbing with a hard brush or sponge!
